Don Rightmyer, editor of Kentucky Ancestors, will discuss the Revolutionary War period and what it meant to those living in the trans-Appalachian part of Virginia. This presentation will serve as a follow-up to Don's previous workshop, "Early Forts and Stations in Kentucky."


