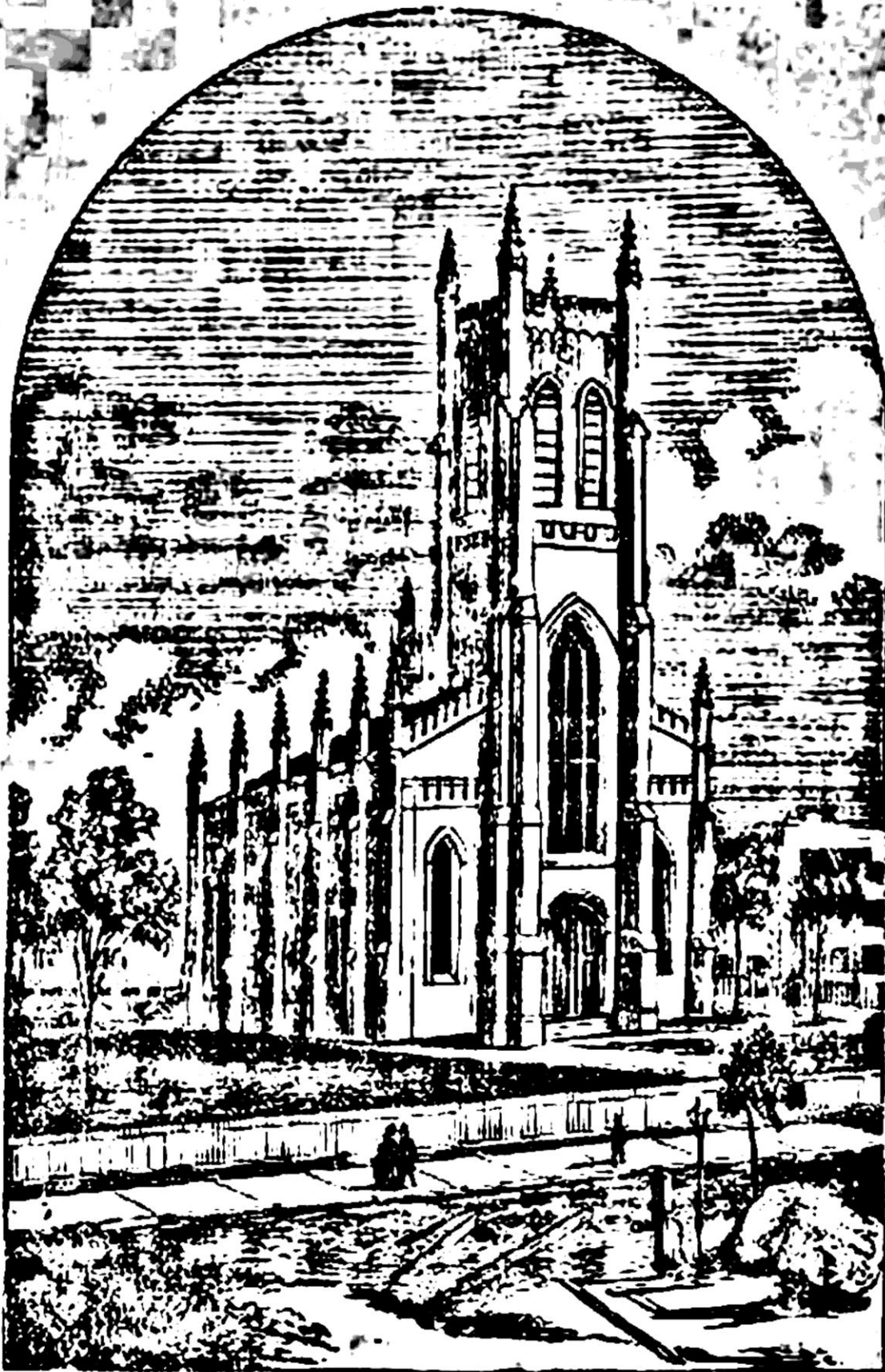
Selections from the Ronald Morgan Postcard Collection

This collection consists of almost 11,000 Kentucky-related postcards collected by Ronald Morgan over a period of ten years.

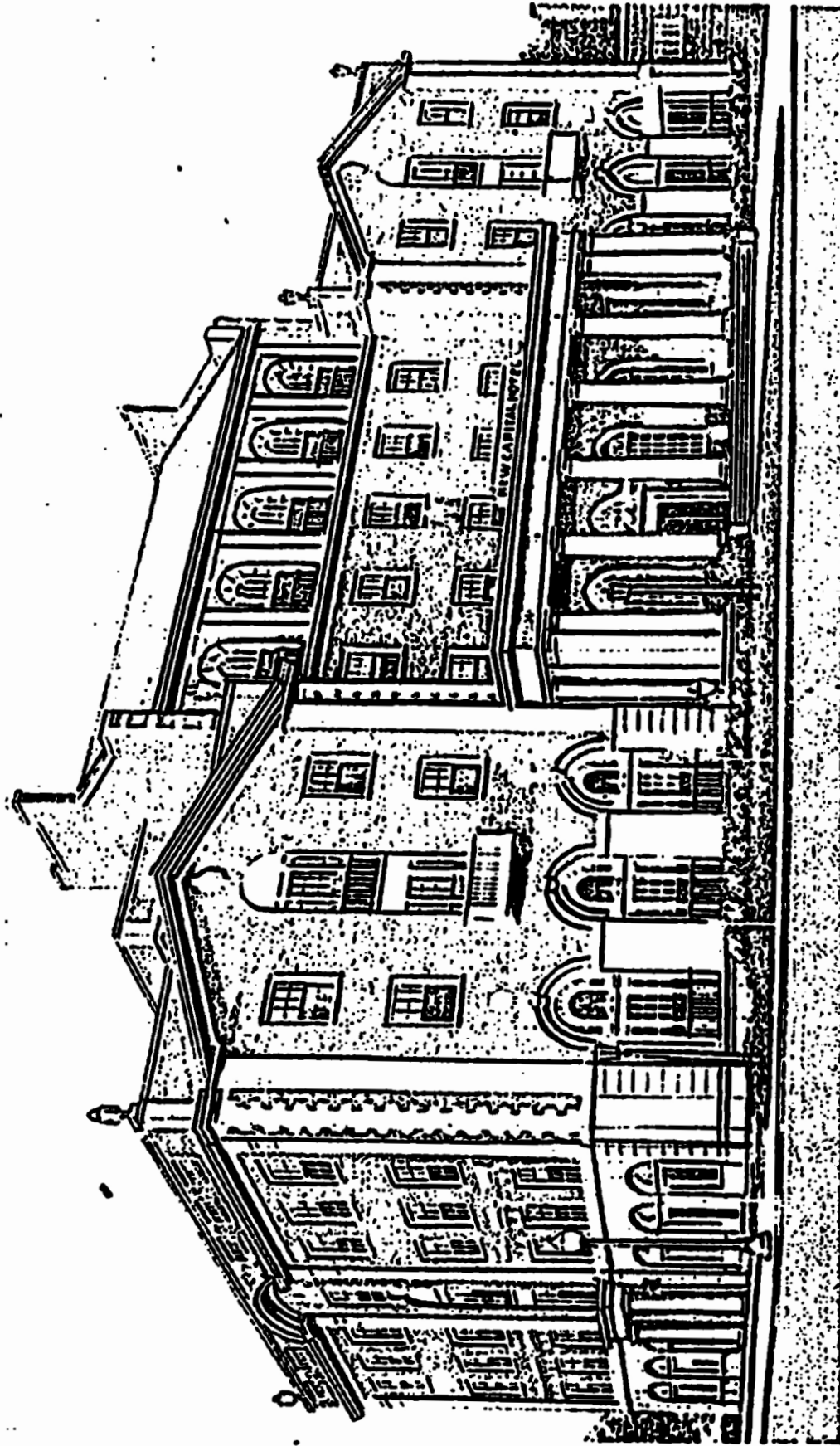

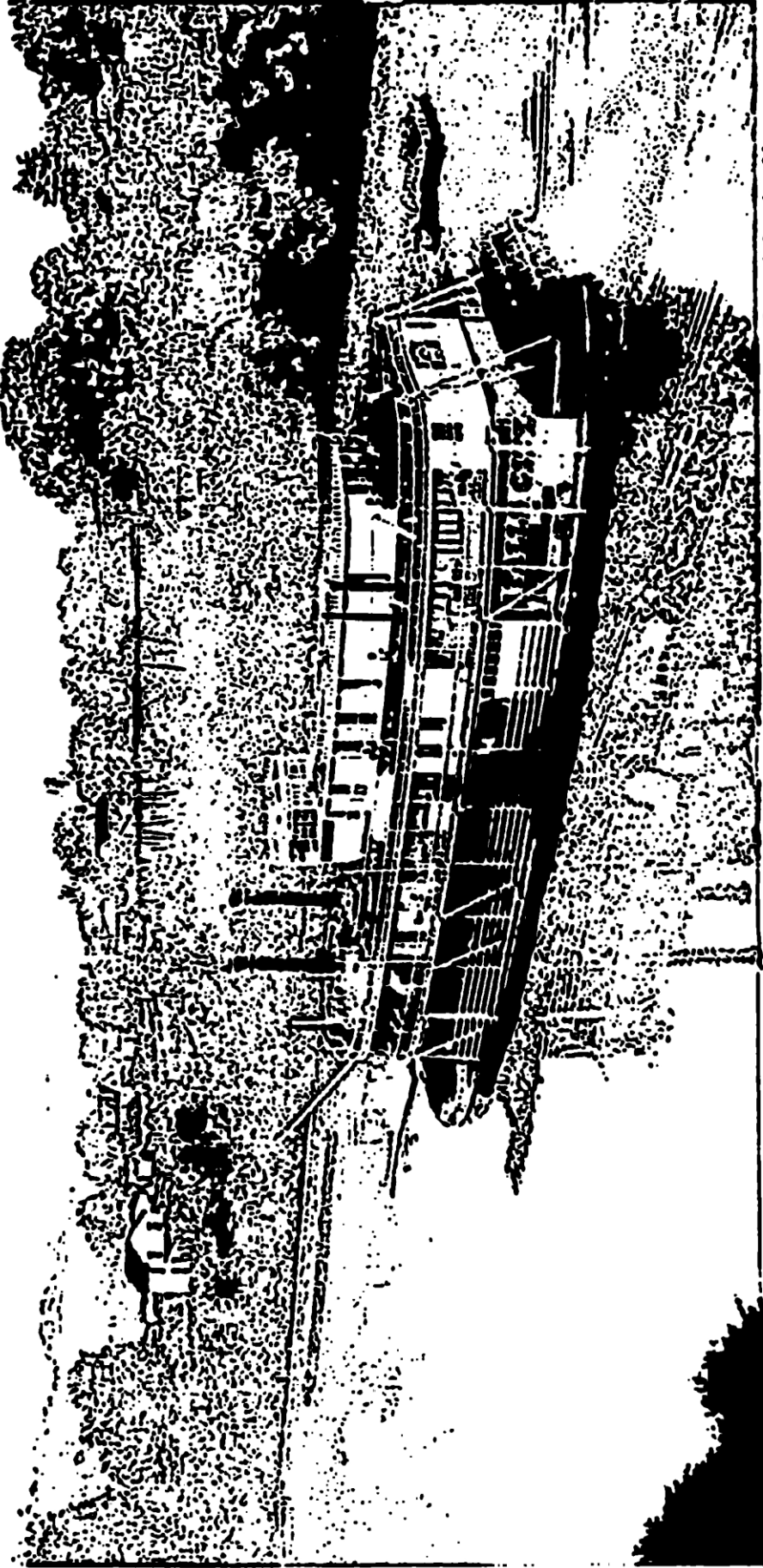


FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH—COR. OGDEN AND SIXTH STREETS.



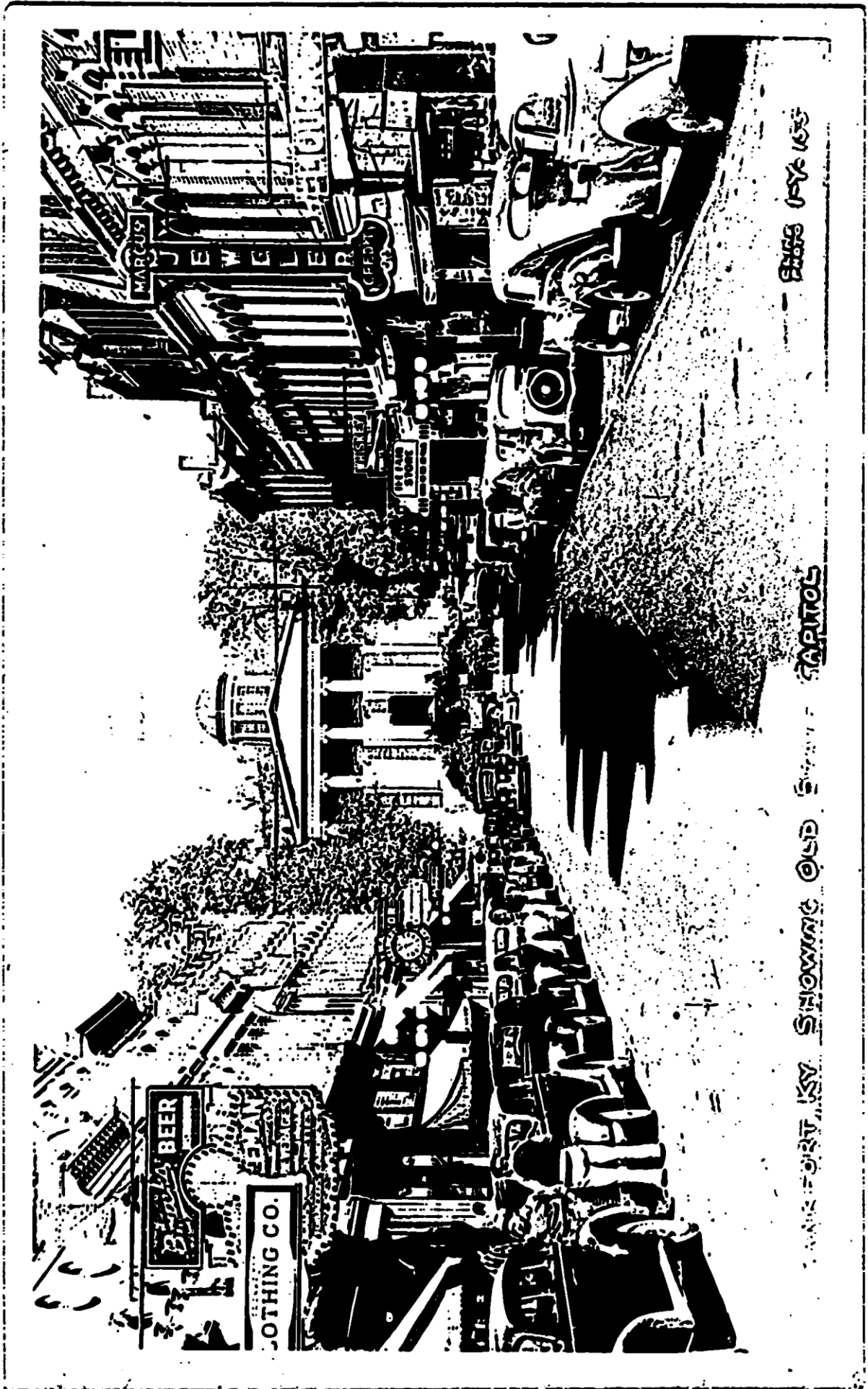
