
Individuals check the box on their Kentucky income tax returns to designate a portion of their refunds to Kentucky's Local History Trust Fund and indicate how much they want to give.



Donations go into a grant pool.



History-minded organizations apply for grant funding each fall. The Kentucky Historical Society administers the grant application process.



Grants support such projects as artifact conservation, UV protection; digitization of photo collections; organizational strategic planning; exhibit planning and implementation; educational program planning and implementation; and more.

Planning grants range from \$290 to \$1,000; implementation grants range from \$290 to \$2,500. Eligible organizations include those with 501c3 status, government agencies, museums, libraries and other history-minded organizations.

For-profit entities and individuals are not eligible to apply for funding from Kentucky's Local History Trust Fund.
